**God's Curriculum:**  
**Striking at the Deepest Part of the Heart**  
*Exodus 20:13 & 14*

**I. Sins that strike at the heart of man.**

**A. Sixth commandment: You shall not murder.**

God protected \_\_\_\_\_:

Genesis 9:6 *"Whoever sheds man's blood, by man his blood shall be shed, for in the image of God He made man..."*

Jesus takes us to the deeper part of the sixth commandment.

Matthew 5: <sup>21</sup> *"You have heard that the ancients were told, 'You shall not commit murder' and 'Whoever commits murder shall be liable to the court.'* <sup>22</sup> *But I say to you that everyone who is angry with his brother shall be guilty before the court; and whoever says to his brother, 'You good-for-nothing,' shall be guilty before the supreme court; and whoever says, 'You fool,' shall be guilty enough to go into the fiery hell..."*

**B. Seventh commandment: You shall not commit adultery.**

At the heart of this commandment is \_\_\_\_\_.

Marriage is based upon the principled practice of \_\_\_\_\_: not on feelings (I Cor. 13:4).

Matthew 5: <sup>27</sup> *"You have heard that it was said, 'Do not commit adultery.'* <sup>28</sup> *But I tell you that anyone who looks at a woman lustfully has already committed adultery with her in his heart.*
