I. Sins that strike at the heart of man.

A. Sixth commandment: You shall not murder.
God protected:
Genesis 9:6 "Whoever sheds man's blood, by man his blood shall be shed, for in the image of God He made man"
Jesus takes us to the deeper part of the sixth commandment.
Matthew 5: 21 "You have heard that the ancients were told, 'You shall not commit murder' and 'Whoever commits murder shall be liable to the court.' 22 But I say to you that everyone who is angry with his brother shall be guilty before the court; and whoever says to his brother, 'You good-fornothing,' shall be guilty before the supreme court; and whoever says, 'You fool,' shall be guilty enough to go into the fiery hell"
B. Seventh commandment: You shall not commit adultery.
At the heart of this commandment is
Marriage is based upon the principled practice of: not on feelings (I Cor. 13:4).
BIGGIE: take (regardless of how long you have been married).
Jesus warns us of the "" of adultery.
Matthew 5: ²⁷ "You have heard that it was said, 'Do not commit adultery.' ²⁸ But I tell you that anyone who looks at a woman lustfully has already committed adultery with her in his heart.
