general. There is no person, people group, or natural disaster beyond His control. Notice that every time God's power is demonstrated, both His people and His creation respond in praise and joy. We should respond the same way. What can you praise God for today?

A Devotional Thought by Jennifer Pierce—

Psalm 65 is a beautiful Psalm that recently encouraged me a lot. When you first read it, you may focus on the acts of God in nature. But I was challenged to notice that God's people praised Him first for the way He interacts with His people on earth, then with the people on earth that are far away (probably meaning Gentiles, who are not His chosen people), then nature in general.

God and His people (vs. 1-5a)

Praise awaits you, O God, in Zion; to you our vows will be fulfilled. O you who hear prayer, to you all men will come.

When we were overwhelmed by sins, you forgave our transgressions.

Blessed are those you choose and bring near to live in your courts!

We are filled with the good things of your house, of your holy temple. You answer us with awesome deeds of righteousness, O God our Savior.

God and mankind (vs. 5b-8)

The hope of all the ends of the earth and of the farthest seas, who formed the mountains by your power, having armed yourself with strength, who stilled the roaring of the seas, the roaring of their waves, and the turmoil of the nations.

Those living far away fear your wonders; where morning dawns and evening fades you call forth songs of joy.

God and nature (vs. 9-13)

You care for the land and water it; you enrich it abundantly.

The streams of God are filled with water to provide the people with grain, for you have ordained it.

You drench its furrows and level its ridges; you soften it with showers and bless its crops.

You crown the year with your bounty, and your carts overflow with abundance.

The grasslands of the desert overflow; the hills are clothed with gladness.

The meadows are covered with flocks and the valleys are mantled with grain; they shout for joy and sing.

May this Psalm be a reminder that God has the power to control nature, the things that directly affect your daily life and the world in
