Challenging Words by Jennifer Pierce

1 Chronicles 28:9 records the words that David spoke to his son Solomon in the presence of all his higher government officials. He said, "As for you, my son Solomon, know the God of your father, and serve Him with a whole heart and a willing mind; for the Lord searches all hearts, and understands every intent of the thoughts. If you seek Him, He will let you find Him; but if you forsake Him, He will reject you forever." These wise words from the man after God's own heart can still challenge our lives today.

How about you? *Do you know God?* No one can know him fully, but do you grow in your knowledge of Him every day? *Do you serve God wholeheartedly?* Do you love both God and yourself? Both God and money? Both God and your reputation? Or do you regularly sacrifice your own desires so that God can be honored in your life? *When you do serve, do you do it willingly?* Willingness comes from the mind, as shown in this verse. It's not an emotion, so we can choose to control it. Are you willing to serve God?

The good news is God knows and understands us completely. He knows that we make mistakes, but He does call us to obedience. He knows when we are seeking Him and when we do seek, He will make it easier on us to find Him. God doesn't expect anything from us that we are unable to give. He asks us to know Him, to serve Him, and to seek Him. He gives the command, we take the steps of obedience, and He provides the power we need.
