## Whom Do You Serve? by Jennifer Pierce

If you have ever studied the Old Testament or even read it a little bit, you may have noticed that many people worshiped a false god named Baal. Over and over again, God told His people Israel not to worship Baal themselves. Worship of Baal was disgusting and sad. Worshipers of Baal cut themselves, hurt other people, and did all kinds of crazy things to show Baal their affection. But Baal was just a stone god, reproduced by whatever artisan had the skill to make the statues.

We don't worship stone gods, but there are many other things that fit the same pattern. The name Baal means master. What things master you? Think about it for a minute. If

you can't imagine life without it or even a day without it, it probably masters you. If you don't think you would survive without it, it may be your master. What is your Baal? And what hardships

your Baal? And what hardships do you inflict on yourself and others in order to serve this master?

I find it extremely interesting that the name Baal has the same meaning as the word Lord that we use for God and Jesus. Why serve any other master that will only make us and those around us miserable when we can serve the True Master who loves us enough to die for us? Paul says in 1 Corinthians 6:12, "Everything is permissible for me, but I will not be mastered by anything." Can you say the same for yourself? Are you tired of being mastered by something or many things that rob you of happiness? Are you tired of feeling hopeless, defeated, and powerless? Don't give up! Change who you serve. In Romans 7, Paul asks, "Who will rescue me from this body of death? Thanks be to God-through Jesus Christ our Lord!" Our Master, Jesus Christ offers deliverance. And his deliverance brings life and peace. Who is your master?
