

We Must Apply by Jennifer Pierce

We all know it's important to attend church, beneficial to be part of a Sunday School class or Bible Study, and crucial to read Scripture on our own. These are all opportunities we have to hear or read God's words to us. Maybe you even invite your friends to join you in these things, and that's great! But what do you do next? When you leave church or close your Bible after reading, what do you do?

God spoke to Ezekiel about this very thing. He said people were coming to hear God's words and even inviting their family to hear Ezekiel speak, but after they heard his words, they didn't do what he said because they would rather seek their own gain. Ezekiel 33:32 says, *"Indeed, to them you are nothing more than one who sings love songs with a beautiful voice and plays an instrument well, for they hear your words but do not put them into practice."* As women, we love beauty and romance. We love a well-played or well-sung song, a skillfully-painted picture, or a romantic movie that makes us cry. But we can't treat God's Word like that. When we hear, read, or study, we <u>must</u> apply.

That's what the parable of the wise and foolish builders (Matthew 6:24-27) is all about. The foolish man building his house on the sand is like the person who hears Jesus' teaching, but doesn't act on it. The wise man is like the person who does act on Jesus' teaching. What about you? Are you just listening to beautiful music and building on sand or are you putting God's teachings into practice and building a house that will endure whatever storm comes? Listen, read, and study as much as you can. But, after that, put it into practice!
