I. Victory turns to defeat.

A. There was victory over Jericho at last (6:15-21).

B. Failure brings _____ (7:1-9).

² Now Joshua sent men from Jericho to Ai, which is near Beth-aven, east of Bethel, and said to them, "Go up and spy out the land." So the men went up and spied out Ai. ³ They returned to Joshua and said to him, "Do not let all the people go up; only about two or three thousand men need go up to Ai; do not make all the people toil up there, for they are few." ⁴So about three thousand men from the people went up there, but they fled from the men of Ai.

C. Failure requires _____ (7:10-18).

7: ¹⁰ So the Lord said to Joshua, "Rise up! Why is it that you have fallen on your face? ¹¹ Israel has sinned, and they have also transgressed My covenant which I commanded them. And they have even taken some of the things under the ban and have both stolen and deceived. Moreover, they have also put them among their own things.

D. Failure demands _____ (7:19-26).

7: ¹⁹ Then Joshua said to Achan, "My son, I implore you, give glory to the Lord, the God of Israel, and give praise to Him; and tell me now what you have done. Do not hide it from me." ²⁰ So Achan answered Joshua and said, "Truly, I have sinned against the Lord, the God of Israel, and this is what I did: ²¹ when **I saw** among the spoil a beautiful mantle from Shinar and two hundred shekels of silver and a bar of gold fifty shekels in weight, then **I coveted** them and **took them**; and behold, they are concealed in the earth inside my tent with the silver underneath it."
