A Call to Praise
Psalm 103

I. PRAISE FOR THE LORD'S MERCIES.

A. Praise God for His _____ (1-5).

¹ Bless the Lord, O my soul, and all that is within me, bless His holy name. ² Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget none of His benefits; ³ Who pardons all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases; ⁴ Who redeems your life from the pit, Who crowns you with lovingkindness and compassion; ⁵ Who satisfies your years with good things, so that your youth is renewed like the eagle.

B. Praise God for His _____ (6-7).

⁶ The Lord performs righteous deeds and judgments for all who are oppressed. ⁷ He made known His ways to Moses, His acts to the sons of Israel.

C. Praise God for His _____ (8-14).

⁸ The Lord is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in lovingkindness. ⁹ He will not always strive with us, nor will He keep His anger forever. ¹⁰ He has not dealt with us according to our sins, nor rewarded us according to our iniquities.

D. Praise God for His _____ (15-18).

¹⁷ But the lovingkindness of the Lord is from everlasting to everlasting on those who fear Him, and His righteousness to children's children, ¹⁸ To those who keep His covenant and remember His precepts to do them.

E. Challenge: Let everyone & everything Praise God (19-22).
