A. The road way (A \_\_\_\_\_ mind).

<sup>3</sup> "Listen to this! Behold, the sower went out to sow; <sup>4</sup> as he was sowing, some seed fell beside the road, and the birds came and ate it up.

B. Rocky ground (The \_\_\_\_\_ mind).

<sup>5</sup> Other seed fell on the rocky ground where it did not have much soil; and immediately it sprang up because it had no depth of soil. <sup>6</sup> And after the sun had risen, it was scorched; and because it had no root, it withered away.
