***Mark 4:1-20***

I. Four soils: Four outcomes.

A. The road way (A \_\_\_\_\_ mind).

<sup>3</sup> *“Listen to this! Behold, the sower went out to sow; <sup>4</sup>as he was sowing, some seed fell beside the road, and the birds came and ate it up.*

\_\_\_\_\_ for the things of God.

B. Rocky ground (The \_\_\_\_\_ mind).

<sup>5</sup> *Other seed fell on the rocky ground where it did not have much soil; and immediately it sprang up because it had no depth of soil. <sup>6</sup>And after the sun had risen, it was scorched; and because it had no root, it withered away.*

C. Among the thorns (The \_\_\_\_\_ mind).

<sup>7</sup> *Other seed fell among the thorns, and the thorns came up and choked it, and it yielded no crop.*

D. The good soil (The \_\_\_\_\_ mind).

<sup>8</sup> *Other seeds fell into the good soil, and as they grew up and increased, they yielded a crop and produced thirty, sixty, and a hundredfold.” <sup>9</sup>And He was saying, “He who has ears to hear, let him hear.”*
