Luke 17:11-19

I. Jesus asked, “Where are they?”

Luke 17: ¹¹ *While He was on the way to Jerusalem, He was passing between Samaria and Galilee.* ¹² *As He entered a village, ten leprous men who stood at a distance met Him;* ¹³ *and they raised their voices, saying, “Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!”* ¹⁴ *When He saw them, He said to them, “Go and show yourselves to the priests.” And as they were going, they were cleansed.* ¹⁵ *Now one of them, when he saw that he had been healed, turned back, glorifying God with a loud voice,* ¹⁶ *and he fell on his face at His feet, giving thanks to Him. And he was a Samaritan.* ¹⁷ *Then Jesus answered and said, “Were there not ten cleansed? But the nine—where are they?”* ¹⁸ *Was no one found who returned to give glory to God, except this foreigner?”* ¹⁹ *And He said to him, “Stand up and go; your faith has made you well.”*
