*Proverbs 7*

**I. The Path Determines the Destination.**

The principle of the path is this: \_\_\_\_\_.

**A. The young man's journey.**

Proverbs 7: <sup>6</sup>*At the window of my house I looked down through the lattice. <sup>7</sup>I saw among the simple, I noticed among the young men, a youth who had no sense.*

**B. The naïve fall prey.**

<sup>15</sup>*So I came out to meet you; I looked for you and have found you! <sup>16</sup>I have covered my bed with colored linens from Egypt. <sup>17</sup>I have perfumed my bed with myrrh, aloes and cinnamon. <sup>18</sup>Come, let's drink deeply of love till morning; let's enjoy ourselves with love!*

What is his future?

<sup>22</sup>*All at once he followed her like an ox going to the slaughter, like a deer stepping into a noose <sup>23</sup>till an arrow pierces his liver, like a bird darting into a snare, little knowing it will cost him his life.*

**C. Lessons:**
