. The Path Determines the Destination.
The principle of the path is this:
A. The young man's journey.
Proverbs 7: <sup>6</sup> At the window of my house I looked down through the lattice. <sup>7</sup> I saw among the simple, noticed among the young men, a youth who had no sense.
B. The naïve fall prey.
<sup>15</sup> So I came out to meet you; I looked for you and have found you! <sup>16</sup> I have covered my bed with colored linens from Egypt. <sup>17</sup> I have perfumed my bed with myrrh, aloes and cinnamon. <sup>18</sup> Come, let's drink deeply of love till morning; let's enjoy ourselves with love!
What is his future?
<sup>22</sup> All at once he followed her like an ox going to the slaughter, like a deer stepping into a noose <sup>23</sup> till an arrow pierces his liver, like a bird darting into a snare, little knowing it will cost him his life.
C. Lessons:
