*“we had the boldness in our God to speak to you the gospel of God amid much opposition.”*

*<sup>3</sup> For our exhortation does not come from error or impurity or by way of deceit; <sup>4</sup> but just as we have been approved by God to be entrusted with the gospel, so we speak, not as pleasing men, but God who examines our hearts. <sup>5</sup> For we never came with flattering speech, as you know, nor with a pretext for greed—God is witness—<sup>6</sup> nor did we seek glory from men, either from you or from others, even though as apostles of Christ we might have asserted our authority.*

E. Paul had a willingness to be \_\_\_\_\_ (7-12).
